These lenses are vastly superior to the previous lenses that have been remanufactured in the past, with these lenses being made out of poly carbonate. The poly carbonate James has chosen is UV resistant, which means they will not suffer from the discolouration that both the reproduced lenses and the genuine Leyland lenses suffer from. They will also be much stronger, which will mean less chance of cracking and breaking.

The lenses that are being made will also be painted with the silver section around the outside of the lense as per the original Leyland spec lense, this means they are supplied ready to install.

Members keep in mind if you don't need a pair now you may in the near future, so you should order now as sometimes you never know if we will have them made again, seize the opportunity & grab a set or 2 while you can. If you order through the club the price will be \$45.00 per set. + postage.


