

A Collectors Dream

After lunch on Saturday we left Mittagong to visit the "SHED" I was expecting to view about 20 to 50 good old cars. Well I was way out it was very hard for me to covey the enormous and magnificent collection of vintage, veteran, classic and modern cars that were on display.

The property was very large, several hundred acres and the original home on the property has been restored to its historic origin.

The cars were mostly housed in what I would call aeroplane hangars, massive slabs of concrete floors, metal buildings with a ceiling height of about 50 feet and the total number of cars would be 800 to 1000 and the owner has rows and rows of all different models. A row of about 20 E type Jags, a row of about 20 3.4 and 3.8 Jags, also Mercedes, old Fords, Chevs, Falcons, Rovers, Hummers, Hilmans, Vauxalls, Chargers and unbelievable number of Range Rovers from way back to modern ones. Maseraties and yes you guessed it he even had Leyland P76's. I could say if you named a car he would most probably have it in his collection, he is an eccentric collector.

The owner also has an extensive range of motor bikes and push bikes, trucks and tractors and a great old speed boat that came from USA New York, it looks like one you would see in a murder mystery. Again the number of bikes on display and packed away is unbelievable.

At the top section of the property he has just built a new "BARN" I guess it could have cost about \$750,000.00 + and this is built of full sand stock bricks and is a 2 storey building with a timber lined ceiling with concealed electricity and all of the cars and bikes in this barn are the ones he is using at the moment and he has a great set up for keeping the batteries charges up.

However I could go on and on, we met the owner and he is a very nice guy and it was most gracious of him to allow our large group to walk through all of his shed and barns at our leisure.

On conclusion I must say that I have watched a lot of great car shows on Foxtel and have never seen a collection as large as this and presented so well.





