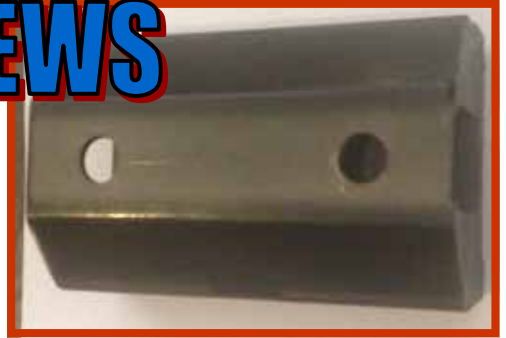

### General Business:

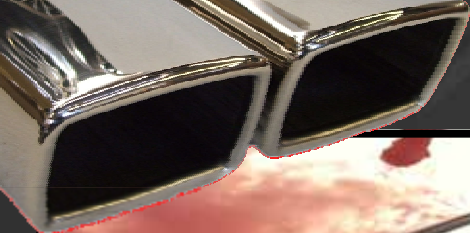
Troy Green gave a report on the proposed P76 Targa Event to be held in July 2014

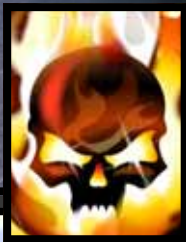

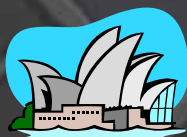
