PRESIDENTS RAMBLINGS

I've been doing some rummaging in the shed looking for serviceable parts for "Sherman's" front suspension and found a couple of surprises I had forgotten about. The lower control arm had an update either late in production or as a replacement part. I remember replacing these items on our Targa in the mid 80s with these beefed up units, had a quick look underneath and yes they

are still there. Why I have only one of these in the parts bin is a mystery. As you can see there is a lot more metal in the Mk2 version.

The strut tops had run their race so I knocked up a pair out of glass reinforced Teflon.

Most of the suspension bits have been painted now and assembly will follow soon as soon as I have sourced some of the rubbery bits which nobody seems to stock these days. Makes restoring these cars all the more fun doing the detective work to find the missing links.



RAMBLINGS CONT.....

I have managed to source bearings for the intermediate steering shaft uni-joint and will replace same this coming week. The mini shafts were rusted and pitted beyond salvaging so had to find replacements for these too. Found some hardened ground 3/8" dowell pins that should fit the bill. Will write a "how to" when the job is done. Also while scrounging found these "C" pillar vents that came off a late build exec that we wrecked years ago.

History of the Leyland P76 Owners Club (SA) Inc. By Chris Cutting

The birth of the Leyland P76 Owners Club (SA) Inc is documented in the following few pages, they are the minutes of the first 2 meetings of the club.

After adverts placed in the Advertiser by Darryl Packham for interested persons to form a club the first meeting was held on the **12 January 1982** at Darryl & Barbara Packham house as you can see there were many in attendance and apologies also given. A name was decided "Leyland P76 Owners Club" a constitution was accepted and Office Bearers were appointed, general meeting date decided and the first Social Day was arranged.

The second meeting was held **9 February 1982** at this time magazines, T-shirts, trips and a meeting venue was being organised and a princely sum of \$200 approx was in the kitty. By now it was known that at least 1 other state NSW was forming a club and it was proposed to offer them our constitution to assist them in forming their club, it was noted in our April minutes that the Sydney Club adopted them. It was also suggested that an annual meeting be held with clubs from all states once they had been formed and the National Meetings were started with the first one being Morpeth in 1984

Due to the Sydney Club being formed it was proposed and accepted that we change our name to the "Leyland P76 Owners Club (SA) Inc"



We have come along way since then, of our current members Jilden joined at the 1st meeting & Nigel & Geoff at the 2nd meeting. Darryl & Barbara Packham are still active in the Queensland Club and many other members have come and

gone. Lots of friendships have been formed through the National meetings & get togethers. We've had lots of fun outings and Christmas parties with my Dad playing Father Christmas back in



the 80's. One of my favorites was the Milk Carton Regatta in 1983 the photo above with our children Felicity (6) & Stuart (9) in the club's P76 made from milk cartoons collected by the members over about 6 months.

There are clubs in all states except Tasmania plus clubs in ACT & New Zealand Many members have traveled far & wide to the National Meetings held every 2 years at Easter or to the get together usually organized in between.

After many years of proposals the Council of Leyland P76 Clubs was formed last year which the SA Club is a member of. The aims include to source or remanufacture parts, promoting the cars and clubs and exchanging information.

Now we have the $40^{\rm th}$ Anniversary Meeting in ACT where the car was launch in June 1973.


