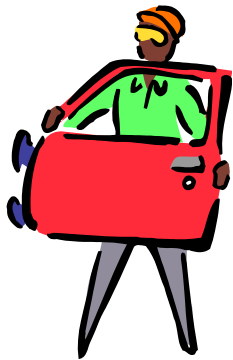
If ever you need a new garden gate or similar for some other enclosure maybe you could try this:-
