PRESIDENT'S RAMBLINGS

For us, the organizing committee for the Easter Nationals, things are gaining momentum. Finalising numbers for meals, confirming pricing for merchandising items, having a guess at what our visitors would like on their menus for the meals, what colour shirts would looks good yet represent us in SA,



all these sort of details have to be sorted. We are progressing well through these challenges.

As we move we are having a monster cleanout along the principle that if we haven't used something during the last 18 months we don't need it. I think this is going to catch us out big time but what do I know.
