### PRESIDENT'S RAMBLINGS

Well here we are and winter is upon us with cold nights and many wet days. Some Club members have headed north looking for warmer climes and at their last report Wayne and Helen were at Minindie Lakes out of Broken Hill and still experiencing cool nights but warmer days. Chris has headed for the UK and when we last spoke was in Southhampton about to hop on a cruise up around the Nordic countries for a week or two. Club meeting attendances are down as well with people choosing to stay home in the warm or not being able to attend for other various reasons.

At work over the last month we have been busy relocating workshops from Lonsdale to a new build at Tonsley in the old Mitsubishi precinct. The theory was to stop all works on a Friday then move and begin operations again a fortnight later on a Monday. This is an engineering workshop which, as in any business has to keep customers happy as well as make money, so this couple of weeks of non-operation was a big hit to the business. We had to move 23 major pieces of machinery including lathes, borers, CNC machine centres, radial drills etc and get them wired up and running the right way as well as setting them up level to achieve the machining accuracy required for high speed rotating equipment refurbishment which is our core business. As well as the machines was over 30 truckloads of tooling, benches, stores, stillages of jobs in progress, racking, measuring equipment, smaller machines, welders, oxy sets etc. that had to be organized and positioned so the place could run again. Largely we achieved this although we are till fine tuning the best place for various things as this is an opportunity for us to "get it right the first time". It is a big exercise.

At home I am modifying the caravan to better store some items on the draw bar. This involves fabricating a box to store fuel for the generator and diesel heater and other sundries and moving the location of the gas bottle storage. There is a lot of angles involved and the old adage "measure twice cut once " comes in to play here. I think it will work out OK. There is a lot of action between the shed and the front yard where the van resides and my old cordless power tools are dying So to enable this project to happen easily, I upgraded my power tools to an 18V combination set from an American Chinese brand that gives me a drill, impact driver, angle grinder, reciprocating saw, circular saw and 1/2" drive impact gun and a torch all cordless and with 3 batteries. It is a real pleasure to not have to run extension leads and have no power cables wrapped around your ankles as you work.
