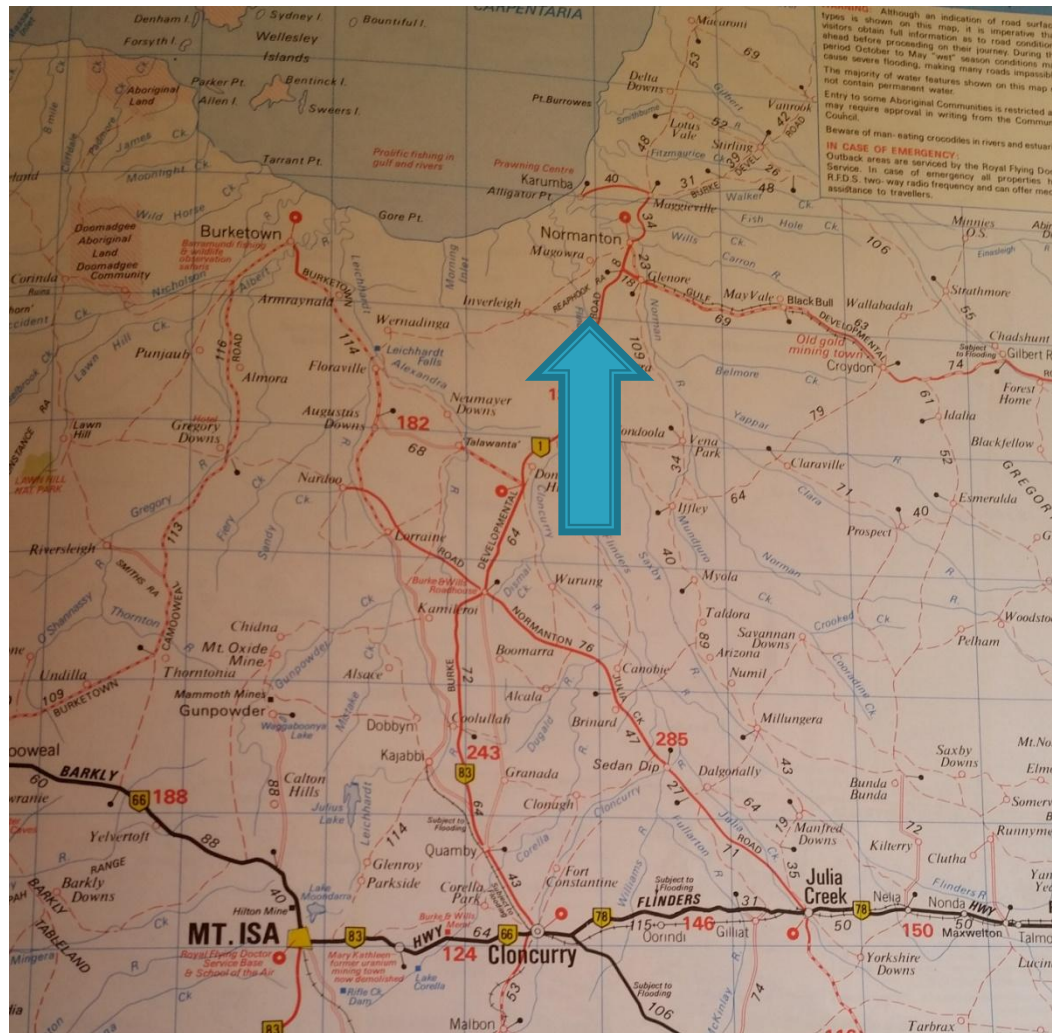

PRESIDENTS RAMBLINGS

Or more so in this case, Presidents Wanderings. This ramble is more of a travelogue than anything to do with the Club but it is what we are doing now, taking a break from the real world and experiencing the life of the "Grey Nomads". It takes a bit of getting used to but it's getting easier every day. Because we have no specific time frame to be anywhere, we can stay as long as we want if the camp is in a good spot. We generally free camp and are only restricted by water availability and periodic requirements for "dump stations". Our solar power is working well keeping the house batteries topped up. We haven't used the generator in the 7 weeks we have been away.

We had a messy start, heading for Birdsville but the weather was against us. We got as far as Farina just north of Lyndhurst where there is an old underground bakery from the Old Ghan railway days open during June, July, run by volunteers, very nice bread. We got rained in there for 2 days and getting out to the main road was a slip sliding affair. We decided that with more rain coming Birdsville wasn't going to happen. South again and east to Broken Hill, Cobar, Bourke and North up through Barcaldine, Longreach, Winton to Cloncurry. Free camps all the way, meeting many lovely travellers doing the same thing. We snuck up this road in the aftermath of lots of rain from a week or 2 earlier and a week later roads were flooded again. We thought it should be getting warmer by this time but apart from the odd t-shirt day, we had a max of 11deg when we got to Mt Isa. Well I suppose it is winter.

We enjoyed time at Corella Dam, west of Cloncurry and Mary Kathleen ghost town which was interesting to see where a whole town existed servicing the uranium mine until shut down in the 1980s. All that is left are the concrete carport slabs from the housing, perfect for parking the caravan on, and the foundations and of shops, bank, police station, swimming pool etc. This town had just about everything. All the houses were auctioned off and many still exist in Mt Isa, Cloncurry and surrounding areas.

We then headed for Lawn Hill, staying at Adels Grove, a very pretty spot where we passed the time kayaking, bushwalking and catching up with clothes washing etc. The National park at Boojamulla about 10 kms away is awesome, we have been there before and it was just as enjoyable as last time. We headed north to Burketown camping on the bank of the Albert River for a few days, didn't see a soul, very peaceful. Turned East to Normanton, sealed road at each end with 170 kms of dirt, reasonable road but our once black Isuzu is now red. Maybe it will rain soon, who knows. We are moving on to Karumba tomorrow for 4 days, glorious sunsets apparently

That's where we are for now, more next time
