PRESIDENTS RAMBLINGS

The journey continues....... We left Pine Creek and headed for Douglas Daly Hot Springs which we had been to a couple of times previously to enjoy the warm waters. Being late in the tourist season we were the only camper there on the first night but had a couple of neighbors later on. The weather was getting quite warm and sticky by now but we managed OK with tree shade and river. After a few days we returned to the Highway and had a couple of days at Hays Creek before wandering up to Adelaide River where we stayed at the showground for several days. Had a couple of good buckets of rain there, just to make it more steamy. On the Saturday night the locals had a rodeo which they do regularly to train the youngsters, girls and boys a young as 3 or 4 on poddy calves (with parental assistance), I think the animals were training as well. Some kids were really confident obviously having been brought up in that environment and other not so but you could see their confidence building as the night progressed. The older boys, about 14-15, I guess, really got into it and were riding bigger animals. One lad went off in an ambulance after a bull calf kicked him after being bucked off. Nothing broken only bruising we were told. Good night's entertainment.

Then the last little stretch to Darwin. Primary reason for this visit was so we could hop over to Bali for son Shane's wedding which we did and he did. Bali was getting hot and steamy too but we went out before the heat in the mornings and lazed around the pool at the resort with a Bintang or 2 in the afternoons. We had found a relatively cheap camp in Darwin at Robbie Robbins Equestrian Centre where we were able to leave the caravan while we escaped to Bali. Caught up with my cousin at Rapid Creek, did some shopping and found a Laundromat to start out clean again for the next leg.

From there we headed south, only choice really, stopping again at Edith Falls for a couple of days, swimming, reading and just chilling. With hot days now we decided to do a few more kilometers than we had been doing to get further down the track so at least the nights are cooler. Destination Elliott. About 10kms west of this little stopover is Longreach Waterhole off Lake Woods. A real oasis, teeming with birdlife and quite unexpected in this dry scrubby country. A flotilla of pelicans (50-60) did a sail past in the morning then came back the other way about an hour later escorted by magpie geese and small shags, feeding all the way so there must have been an abundance of fish as well. Spent 3 days there.

On to Devil's Marbles, campground fairly busy, stayed 2 nights, and blew a gale on the 2nd night which had us packing up the awning at about 2 in the morning to save it from taking off altogether. A couple of vans away from us had enjoyed a campfire earlier and the wind blew embers right across the campground luckily not in our direction. They had buckets of water on it quick smart. All calm in the morning and we continued on to Alice Springs for a couple of days to get the laundry done and stock up the larder. We had thought about going across the Plenty Hwy to Birdsville but they had had rain so we thought it prudent not to.

On the home stretch now, a couple of overnighters down the highway to Port Augusta, Port Pirie and then home to sort out 5 months of mail and an overgrown back yard. All back on track now. Been home for 10 days then took off again for Bendigo for the Swap Meet and wandered around the north west of Victoria for a couple of weeks. Home to do some maintenance now.
