PRESIDENT'S RAMBLINGS

Continuing on with our travels, it's mid June in mid NSW so still not very warm. Down near zero at night but the days are clear and sunny, high teens.

Had a couple of days in **Parkes**, went out to The Dish, quite extraordinary what these guys are seeing out in space, to what end I'm not sure.

Headed NE to **Yeoval** and Gulgong, Banjo Patterson and Henry Lawson country up here. My mum spent some of her childhood in **Gulgong** so we spent some time in the museum where we found a school photo of class 2 1929 with my auntie in it. The house mum lived in is still occupied, I had a chat with the current owners before taking a couple of photos to show Mum.

Moved on to **Merriwa** then **Maitland** where we caught up with Moloneys at Beresfield and a couple of my cousins in Newcastle. Took a left turn and headed north arriving in **Nabiac** early afternoon where we found the National Motorcycle Museum and were able to camp for free in the car park, bonus. 800 odd bikes are on display here, everything from Ariels to Zundapps, examples of many of the 20 or so bikes I have owned on display. Spent many hours in there, well worth a look.

Continued on to **Macksville** for a couple of days, **Grafton**, Braemer roadside stop, through **Casino** and on to Warnocks at **Coffee Camp** out the back of Lismore.

Stayed for a week there with trips Lismore, **Kyogle** and **Nimbin** and caught up on washing etc. next stop **Murwillumbah**. The Grainery there was an interesting shop, recycling all sorts, particularly lighting, although the owner was a nuisance, wouldn't leave us alone.

After 2 days there, headed for **Beenleigh** on Brisbane's South side, rained most of the day. Caught up with old friends and Di's Aunty while in the area. Moved on to Caboolture where we planned to stay and catch up with Rogersons at **Narangba**, but the Showgrounds had something on and we couldn't stay there so we kept going to Kilcoy.

Stayed for a few days there and backtracked to Rogersons to visit for a couple of hours. They were busy prepping the house for sale to downsize, big job. It was good to see them again. While at **Kilcoy**, went down to Somerset Dam and put the kayak in the water for a couple of hours, nice spot. Moved on to Moore for a couple of days then up to **Linville** which is on the Brisbane Valley bike trail, I rode up the trail to **Blackbutt** for a few kilometres but there were a lot of sharp stones so I didn't push my luck as I didn't carry any puncture repair stuff. Nice ride though, many groups riding right through.

Moved on NW to **Nanango** overnight then on to **Kingaroy**, peanut country. Few days there to see the sights, Flo and Jo's place, museum at the info centre etc. Moved on to **Murgon**, nice free camp here near town centre. Star Theatre was an impressive old building now a second hand shop with everything including the kitchen sink. Continued on to **Gayndah**, stayed near a railway siding for \$5 a night, caught up on washing etc. **Munduberra** next for a couple of days went kayaking at Jones's Weir. Travelled on to **Wurruma Dam**, free camp, kayaking, locals were catching plenty of red claw. Motored on to **Monto**, nice little town, day trip to Cania Dam for a kayak, I don't know why we don't have access for water sports on our reservoirs in SA.

Biloela next stop, couple of days there, thunderstorm during the night. Headed to **Rockhampton**, through Mt Morgan, old mining area, really steep switchback road coming down off the range, Di didn't like it much. Stayed just out of Rocky but had a good look around. Went out to Yeppoon, (where's Yeppoon? Next to ya knife and fork) Emu Park etc, nice bit of coast.

Had to get a new solar panel regulator for the portable set up, the unit had suffered an internal meltdown.

We were only going to come this far North but on checking what the weather was doing we decided to stay up in these latitudes a little longer, so we headed north for **Marlborough** then **St Lawrence** just relaxing in the warm. Moved on, **Ilbilbie** overnight behind the service station, close to highway so a bit noisy, headed on towards **Mackay** staying at Moana RV Park as a base to check out Sarina, the coast and Mackay.

Sugar cane country here with plenty of activity and huge coal export facilities. Still amazed that we are exporting all this coal and shutting down our coal fired power stations. Surely we can use the technology they have in Japan and China to burn "clean coal", but that's an argument for another time.

Heading south again now towards Emerald.

Hoping this finds you all well and a note for SA travellers. You can get Farmers Union Iced Coffee just about everywhere up here now. We should be home by the time the next magazine comes out
