

Dear Leyland P76 Owners Club SA Incorporated

I refer to my letter of 4 January 2017 seeking input on proposed changes to the Conditional Registration scheme for Historic Vehicles, Prescribed Left Hand Drive Vehicles and Street Rod Vehicles (the Scheme).

I have received many letters from representatives of motor vehicle clubs supporting the proposed changes to simplify the Scheme.

I am pleased to advise that I have received overwhelming support for the changes, receiving over 200 written responses to the public consultation earlier this year and a petition of support listing more than 2,300 signatures.

I will be progressing the proposed changes in full, with an intended implementation date of 1 July 2017.

Conditional Registration was introduced in 1992 and has always been a Scheme to support motoring enthusiasts within the State's car clubs. The changes and relaxation of some of the Scheme requirements, specifically around vehicle inspections, has prompted some discussion within several car clubs.

I can confirm that the minimum standards set by the South Australian Government will not mandate a physical vehicle inspection to be undertaken by a car club for Scheme entry. This is because the revised Scheme's vehicle requirement chiefly relies upon a vehicle's age rather than prescriptive vehicle originality.

However, the legislation retains the capacity for car clubs to require a club vehicle to be made available for inspection by the club. Car clubs, by their constitutions, will also retain the ability to set vehicle inspection requirements as they see fit. I am also ware that some car club constitutions articulate a key objective of the club being vehicle originality. In these circumstances, some car clubs may wish to continue requiring vehicle inspections as part of club membership. Other clubs may choose to remove the requirement for inspection.

As this Scheme is specifically designed for the car clubs to administer, the power will remain with the clubs to individually decide on their own requirements regarding vehicle inspections. Vehicle inspections for Scheme entry will not be mandated in the revised Code of Practice for the Scheme.

Once the changes are implemented on 1 July 2017, registration approval processes for newly conditionally registered vehicles will follow a process similar to the existing Scheme arrangements. In particular, arrangements for car club endorsement and issuing of vehicle log books will be largely unchanged. The Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure is currently working to simplify registration forms and revise the Code of Practice for the Scheme.

If you wish to supply any feedback in relation to registration processes under the revised Scheme, I encourage your members to continue providing feedback, via your club, to the Federation of Historic Motoring Clubs South Australia Incorporated, The Australian Street Rod Federation Incorporated or the Street Machine Association of South Australia (SMASA).
