PRESIDENT'S RAMBLINGS

Here we are at the end of another year and we find ourselves warily getting back to some sort of normal living. Big crowds still don't excite me much and we pick our times to go shopping etc. but we are managing.

As a Club we have almost completed our 40th year in existence and arguably the first P76 Club in Australia to have a constitution. Although now pretty thin on the ground we still have our meetings and the occasional event.

40 years ago, we had many more members and the enthusiasm was there for the P76 which wasn't even 10 years old at that stage. In July that year we had \$148 on the bank and plans were afoot for the club to deliver business directories to prop up the funds. I still have a scar on my leg from a friendly collie bite who wasn't impressed by my accessing "his" front yard to deliver the book to the front door. Not sure how much we made doing that but treasurer's report at the October Meeting quoted \$1189.35 which was probably annual subs as well as the fund raiser.

We had a picnic day on the river at Sedan with some water skiing involved and even a P76 powered ski boat as I recall.

A P76 parts interchangeability list got off the ground as even at that early stage some parts were becoming hard to source. I still have one of these books in my pile. Strangely, factory workshop manuals were not too common at that time. A copy was donated to the Club by a member and various bits and pieces were republished in our monthly magazines as appropriate.

We began collecting milk cartons in anticipation of building a water going P76 for the upcoming Milk Carton Regatta at Glenelg in February 1983, approximately 3500 had been collected by the build date, a pretty good effort when you think about it. That's 3 and a half tonnes of milk, our bones are thanking us for it now, I'm sure. The result of the regatta, well that's another story.

We had proper Christmas Parties back then probably because there were kids everywhere. Christmas tree, Father Christmas, presents for the kids and of course plenty of food and drinks.

The Club was selling Force 7 handbooks (limit 1 per member) for \$2.50 each and Club T-shirts for \$4.50 each.

And so we move on 40 years, some early members are still around and others have moved on, our cars were mostly daily drivers back then and have now moved to a different pecking order in the shed but they are still with us and thankfully have been the link to longstanding friendships over the years.
